Absences of Pollard White ~~for May~~ and Norman Lazare for the May meeting were excused.


After a most excellent dinner the program was called and the ~~members~~ <sup>these</sup> members read the papers as opposite their names:

was instructed to call the program:


Pollard White presented-----"Birddogs"
