There being no other business to bring before the Society-the secretary was instructed to call the program for the evening.


Thos. Sovars read a paper entitled:

Gene Farley presented a paper entitled:



Thos. Morris presented a paper entitled:



Mr. Ward, the vote was favorable.


The program for the evening was called by the secretary:

"An Elementary Discourse On Inflation"


The papers were well received and a lively discussion followed,; 14 members participating.
